6.01 R. M. of Lac du Bonnet – golf tournament invitation

A letter from the RM of Lac du Bonnet regarding the 100th Anniversary / Municipal Golf Tournament being held on July 6, 2017 at Granite Hills Golf Course. Proceeds will be donated to the Youth Centre.

The RM is combining their annual golf tournament and expecting it to be bigger and better than before.

6.02 Young Canada Works – Grant Submission

The Library was unsuccessful in their bid for a Young Canada Works grant. However they indicated that should they get supplemental funding our

application would be reconsidered.

6.03 Follett – Destiny Library Manager costs for 2017 Follet has advised that as of July 1, 2017 the annual cost of the Destiny Library Manager will increase by 5% (current cost \$733.83 which will increase to \$770.53, an increase of \$36.70). We are paid up until March 2018.

6.05 Library and Archives Canada (LAC)

LAC has a new agreement for a new Library Management Service with the International non-profit library cooperative. This will allow world-class services and an opportunity to make the published heritage more visible and share Canada's culture and knowledge with the world. LAC will cover the costs for this service for small libraries.

6.06 Library Funding 2017/2018

The Minister of Sport, Culture and Heritage has advised that the annual funding of \$39,491.50 has been approved and is forthcoming.
